Understanding person- centered care concepts and approaches means a little something different for each resident. - Growing strong relationships/partnerships with resident's and families
- Safeguarding against adverse events
- Promoting good outcomes

The best way to learn what person-centered care means for each resident is to ask them, get to know them as a person, and let each person's strengths and interests breathe life into the care and services provided daily.
